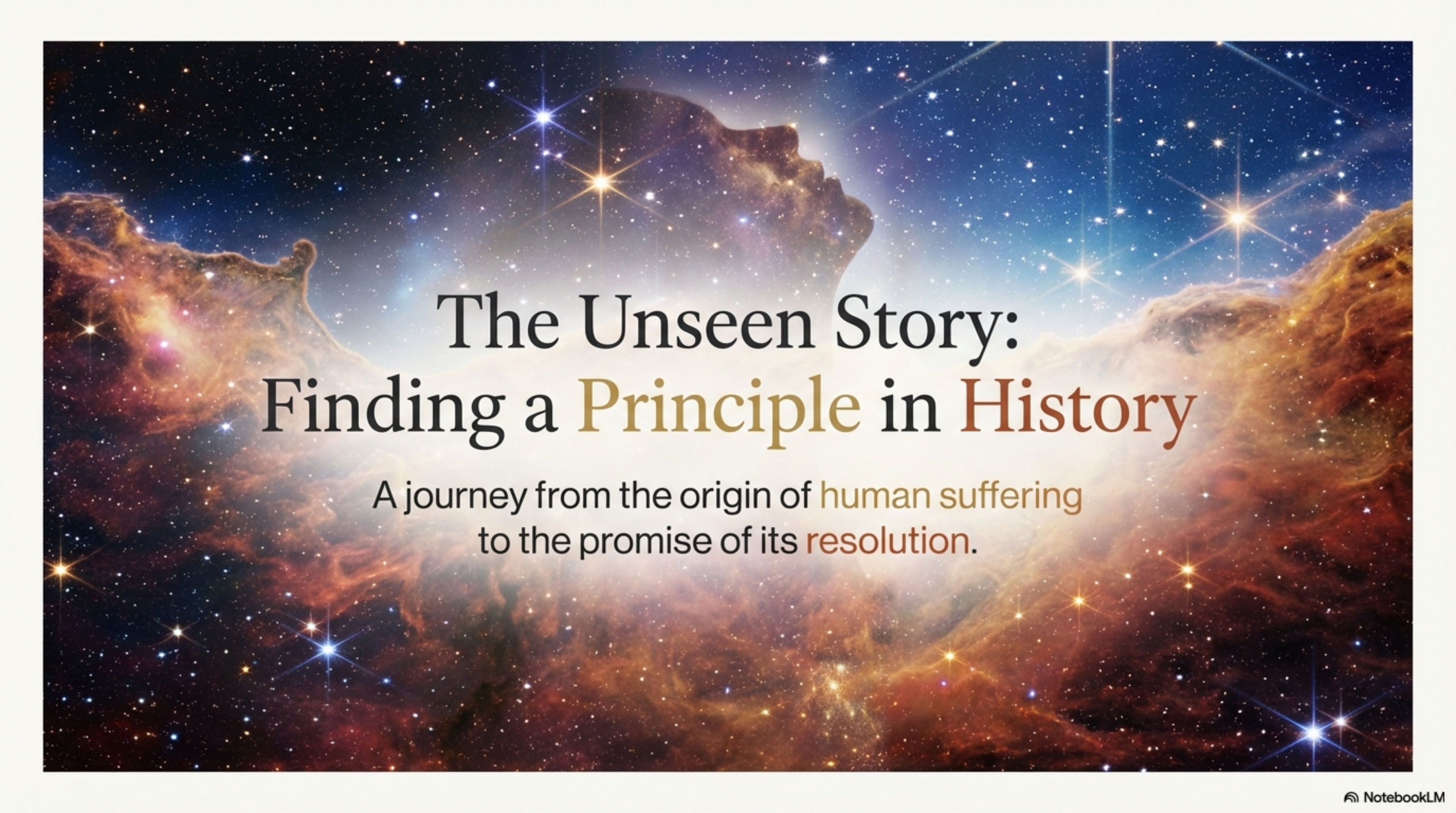


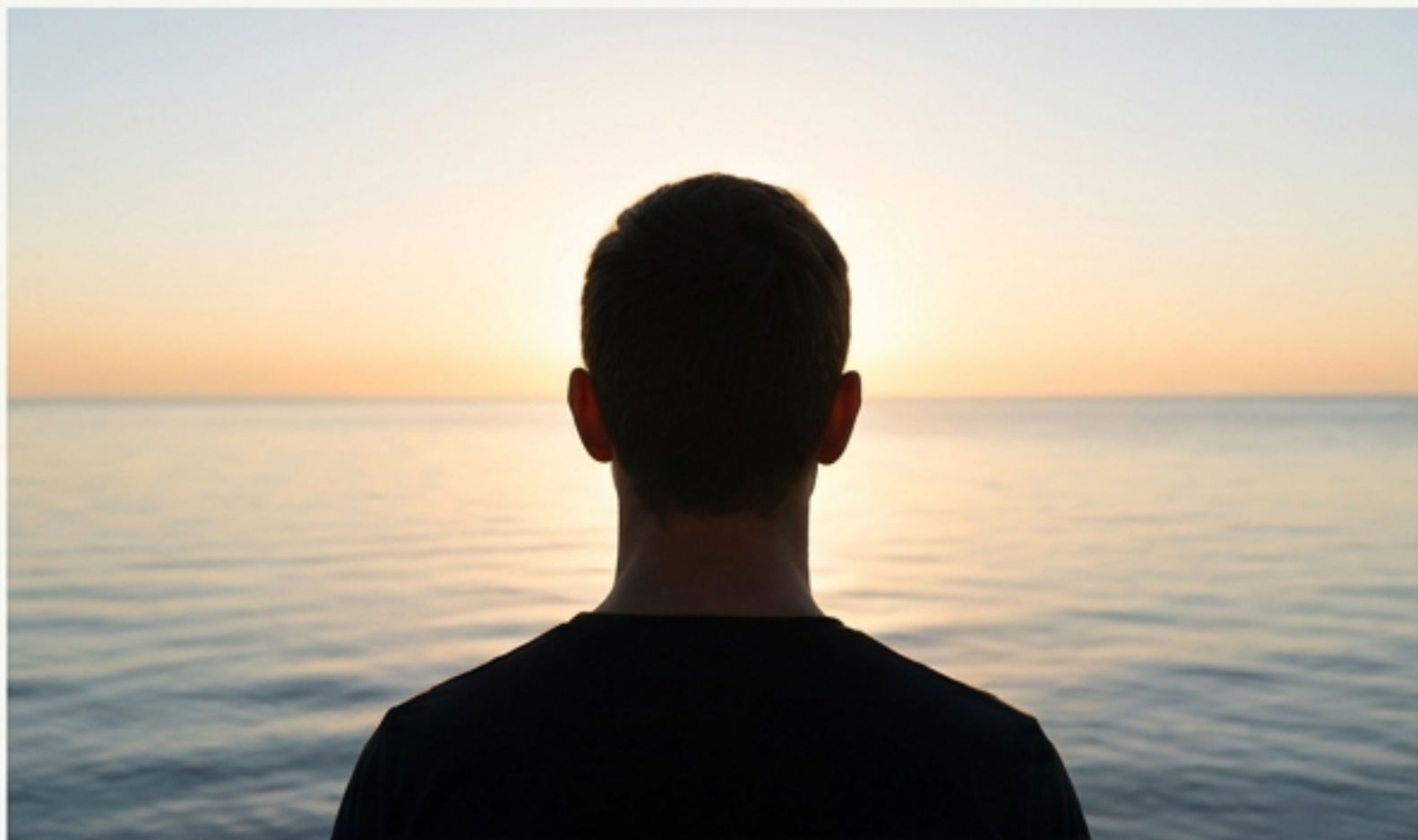

The root of sin was an illicit sexual relationship between the angel Lucifer and Eve, severing humanity's lineage from God and grafting it onto a satanic one.

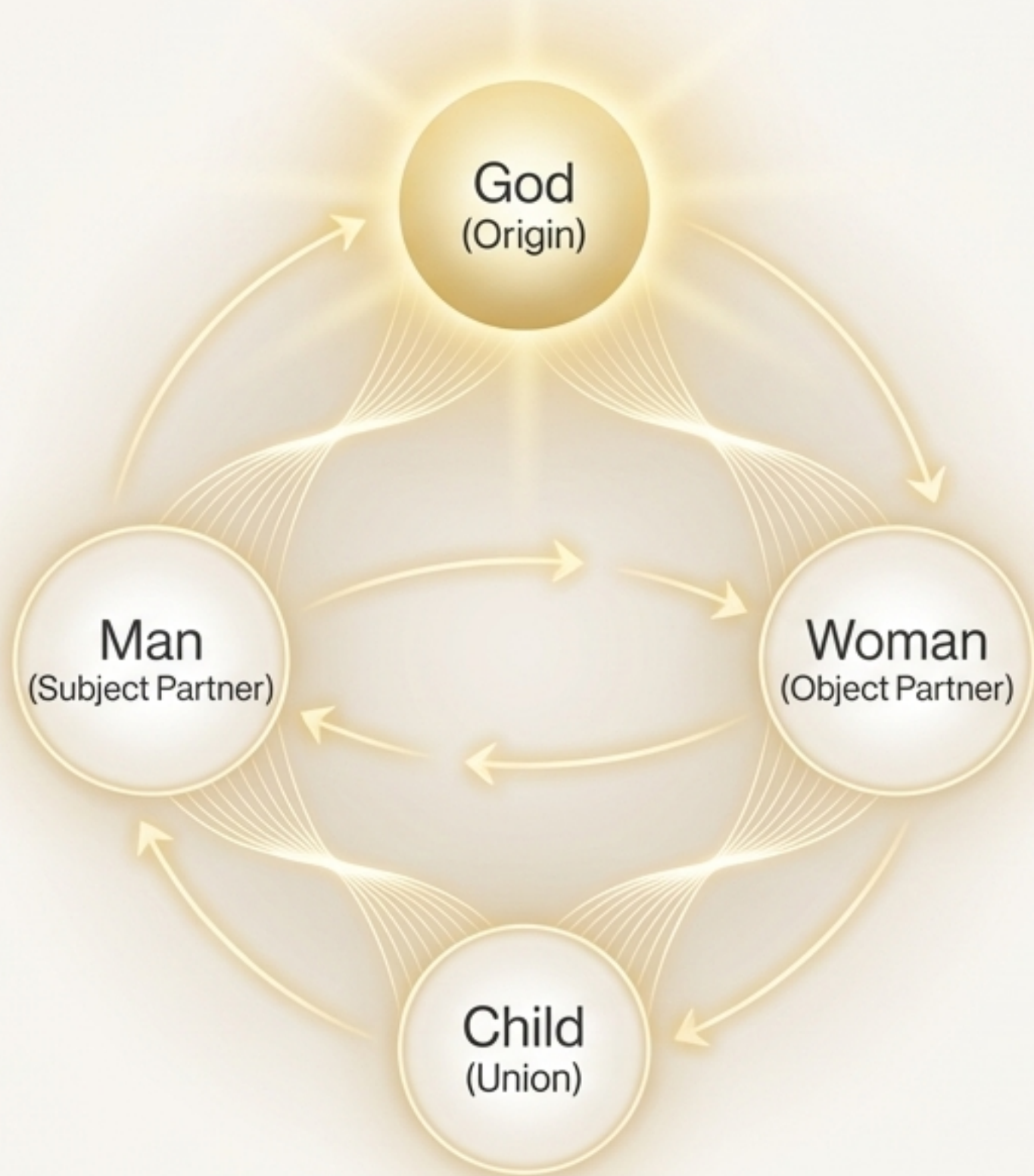
Salvation, Interrupted.

Restoring the Balance

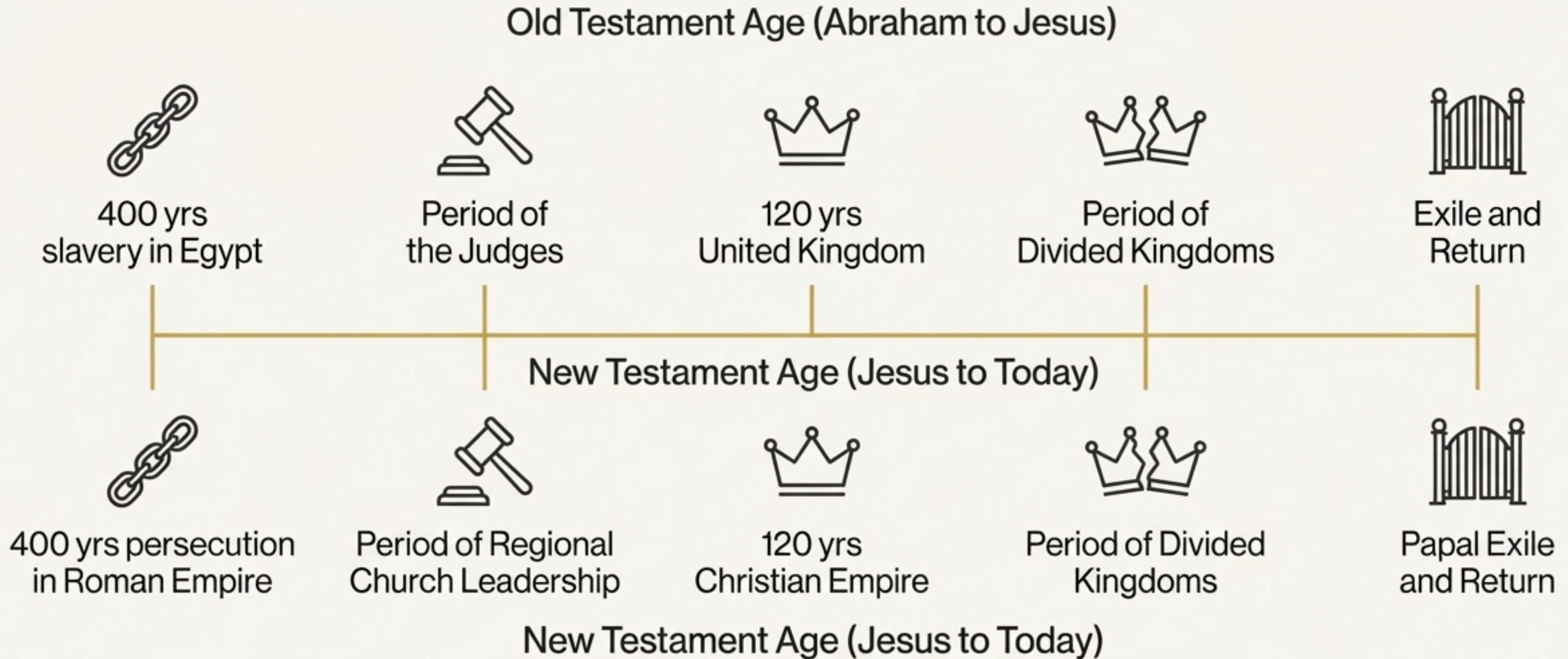


History is God's work to restore the original blueprint through the principle of **Indemnity**.
